

GHO Scholarships

GHO Scholarships are offered throughout the year to deserving members of GHO in each of the following categories. To be eligible for a Scholarship, candidates must follow the criteria for the specific award and submit the application and any required supporting documents

RELI Scholarship

Guidelines:

- GHO will offer two registration scholarships to Housing/Residence Life New Professionals working in the state of Georgia to attend the Regional Entry Level Institute.
- Recipient selection is the responsibility GHO Awards & Recognition Committee.
- Applications are due by April 8, 2011 to Megan Horan at mhoran@uga.edu
- The Executive Board of GHO will establish criteria for selection.

Eligibility:

- Candidate must be employed full time by a Housing/Residence Life Department.
- Candidate must have applied and been selected for the RELI conference of the current year.
- Candidate must have contributed or demonstrates an interest in contributing to GHO in the current/next academic year.
- Candidate has been working less than 3 years

Application Material:

- A letter indicating why he/she is applying, including how the RELI conference will benefit his/her current institution and/or GHO.
- A current resume.
- A letter of support from his/her Chief Housing or Student Affairs Officer or supervisor (max. 2 pages).
 - Identify how applicant has shown personal initiative to pursue a career in student affairs and demonstrated competence such as the following:
 - S/he has sought to be a contributing member of the student affairs department.
 - S/he has sought to broaden her/his own base of professional understanding through participation and involvement in other organizations and continuing education.
 - S/he has sought to broaden her/his own understanding of diverse student needs.

Graduate Student Scholarship

Guidelines:

- GHO will offer two graduate registration scholarships to Housing/Residence Life graduate students working in the state of Georgia to attend the GHO Annual Conference.
- Recipient selection is the responsibility of GHO Awards & Recognition Committee.
- Applications are due by September 20, 2010 to Megan Horan at mhoran@uga.edu
- The Executive Board of GHO will establish criteria for selection.

Eligibility:

- Candidates must be full time graduate students employed by a Housing/Residence Life Department.
- Candidates who express financial need.

Application Material:

- A letter indicating why he/she is applying.
- A current resume.
- A letter of support from his/her Chief Housing or Student Affairs Officer or supervisor (max. 2 pages).
 - Identify how applicant has shown personal initiative to pursue a career in student affairs and demonstrated competence such as the following:
 - S/he has been actively involved in their department, through committee involvement and other initiatives.
 - S/he has demonstrated a concern for students through their involvement outside the department (involvement in campus committees, organizations, etc.).
 - S/he has expressed an interest in the planning and preparation of future conferences.
